


AS WE GATHER



born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried. He descended into hell. The third day He rose again from the dead.


He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father Almighty.

Pastor: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.


People: It is right to give Him thanks and praise.

THE WORDS OF OUR LORD






900 Jesus! Name of Wondrous Love

- 6 Jesus! Name of wondrous love, Human name of God above; Pleading only this, we flee Helpless, O our God, to Thee.




970 Jesus, Name above All Names (Sung Through Twice)




